1.	 Confirmation of agenda The agenda was unanimously approved by the meeting. SvdM invited the meeting to add points to the agenda if required, but no further points were proposed. 	
5.	Chairman's report	
	 5.1 Overview and status of FMK projects and activities The FMK constitution was recently amended at a Directors meeting, stating that a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 6 directors must be appointed. Discovery and Sensory Trail Project: Phase 1 of the project which includes a wooden rest deck and toilet combination as well as a bird hide and paved parking is in use but we have a serious shortage of water for the toilet facility. Nature Conservation organized the connection to the sewer. The water supply to the reservoir for the toilet continues to be a point of concern that must be addressed as a matter of urgency. Removing alien plants and trees from the Reserve: This problem is being addressed. Nature conservation is in the process of cleaning up. We also endeavour to obtain the involvement of Schools and Training Institutions to remove reeds and water plants from the dam. Protection of the Palisade Fence: We are actively seeking donors to help our partner, Nature Conservation, with the Protection of the palisade fence by means of a professional rust convertor. We have painted approximately 300 metres in Rutgers street. We still have a long way to go but, with the help of Nature Conservation and donations we will succeed. Events: Jeannie is organizing regular events and outings to promote the Moreleta kloof 	
	 5.2 Highlights The bird hide is functional and well used. Reduction of game in the Kloof to address overgrazing. 5.3 Concerns Condition of the Palisade Fence. 6.1.	 Overview and approval of 2013/2014 financial statements JV presented the FMK 2012-2013 financial statements. These financial statements will be made available on the FMK website. The meeting unanimously approved the financial statements. JV mentioned that the problem with SARS was sorted and that a TAX Clearance Certificate was issued but that someone will have to be nominated to retrieve this certificate from SARS. 7. 7.1.	 Moreleta Kloof projects and activities Palisade maintenance Palisade maintenance continues to be a problem that requires ongoing attention. Through donations a 300m stretch of fence was painted in Rutgers street with the preferred high quality rust resistant paint. There are 30liters of paint already paid for, as soon as FMK acquires reliable labour, painting will continue first in Rutgers and then around the rest of the fence. AM said that there is an initiative from the city council, "the Poverty relief project" that will be used to prepare and paint the fence, they will either start in Blouhaak or the fence in Rubenstein between Rutgers and Jacques Street which also needs urgent attention. The fence on the opposite side where the construction work is in progress will be attended to when the construction has been completed. AM can be contacted directly when more paint becomes available. SvdM thanked AM for their role in the continued maintenance of the palisade fence. 	SvdM, AM
7.2.	 FMK Membership and involvement JdP said that there is only a small number of people (FMK members) that visit the Kloof regularly and that the other members are not involved. Little to no support when it comes to clean-up activities in the Kloof. EvZ is involved with other friends groups and suggested that the less pleasant activities such as clean ups be combined with fun activities i.e. "Kleilat-gooi" HC said that Hoerskool Waterkloof pupils have done a lot in the Kloof, SvdM said that she must please pass along the relevant contact details so that he can send them a letter of appreciation from FMK. There will be a discussion during the next directors meeting to identify areas and ways to increase membership involvement. AM suggested a WhatsApp group for FMK members. This can be used to keep member up to date on happenings in and around the Kloof as well as serve as a means to communicate the needs of/ problems experienced by the FMK directors to actively involve members in Kloof management activities. 7.3.	 FMK marketing, new signage, display cabinet and regulations JdP said that the display cabinet at the information den looks bad and is in dire need of repair. JdP received quotations for the repair, but a notice wil be put on the Facebook page and new WhatsApp support group to see if there is someone that will be able to assist with this problem. Nature Conservations is putting up a roof, 5x10m and this can then be used for talks. 	JdP, AM
7.4.	 Clean-up, clearing of invader plants JdP thanked the Work for Water team, they are doing a wonderful job. The reeds at the hide is also problematic, there are ways to treat them with biological poison, JdP will follow up and give feedback. There will be a discussion at the next directors meeting regarding getting someone in to do clean-up on a regular basis and the funds needed for this. Friends and other community members will also be asked to supply labour for clean-up in the reserve via Facebook and the new WhatsApp group 	JdP
7.5.	 Water supply to toilet Nature Conservation wants to transfer the account to the city council and then bill Rademeyers for their use separately (meter already installed). The water for the toilet as well as the proposed future facility at the entrance will then be on the municipality's account. But before this can happen, the overdue amount on the account must be settled, there are plans in place for this to happen. The alternative, a "dompel pomp" is problematic as the river's water level varies a lot and environmental approval will have to be obtained. 	AM

	AM said that she had given orders that the tank must be filled every Friday and that she must be notified if this does not occur.	
7.6.	 Differential access control options Proposal in process, once finished it will be brought before the directors and nature Conservation with feedback given the the friends. There is a problem with people signing in but not signing out, this will be address in the proposal. JdP said that the guards available currently are doing a good job. 	AMR
7.7.	Absa Payment Pebble Could possibly be a cost effective way to offer an avenue for donations to FMK by visitors to the Reserve. The possibility will be investigated and discussed at the next directors meeting.	JdP
7.8.	Construction c/o Blouhaak and Rubenstein New contractor was finally appointed, the site will be handed over to them on Monday 3/11/2014.	AM
7.9.	 Sewage leaks and pollution Continuous problem. JdP reports problems as soon as they arrive but it sometimes takes days before the problems are fixed. Pipelines are not sufficiently maintained and fixed. JdP looked into different options, will contact Roto Rooter and ask if they will be willing to properly clean the most problematic line. The rain is helping to clear away some of the pollution. 	JdP
7.10.	 Review Jeannie du Plessis' points for discussion (email attached) Point 4. More open meetings should be held where people can discuss events in the Kloof and the problems that arise. It was reiterated that JdP was welcome to meet with her supporting team at any time to discuss issues, but that the board of directors should be kept informed regarding problems that arise and decisions to be made and events organised. Point 9. Erica van Zyl informed the meeting that Civil Engineering students from UP will be doing their practical work in the Moreletakloof reserve. They will be attempting a "pre rehabilitation" project to protect the wetland (prevent damage). Repair the bridge and build small banks up and downstream of the bridge. – this is a Moreletaspruit initiative. Sarel thanked them on behalf of the friends. 	JdP
7.11.	 Tshwane Nature Conservation inputs and feedback regarding Status of game in the reserve (Quantities per type, medium term management plan, risks, highlights) AM proposed the possibility of a VA instead of a Section 21 as this will put less stress on directors. This option will be thoroughly investigated and discussed during the next directors meeting and feedback given 'n the decision. Nature Conservation removed ¾ of the buck and brought in new rams to prevent inbreeding and overgrazing. 5 new "rooi ribbokke" was introduced to the reserve last week, a new species to the reserve. Approximately 12 springbok rams still need to be removed to improve the balance between males and females. Documentation to proclaim Moretelakloof Nature reserve as a reserve has been handed in and is currently at provincial level. This is a slow and lengthy process, AM follows up every 2 months. Faerie Glen has been proclaimed and we should be next. AM thank FMK for their continued support and contribution and SvdM also thanked Nature Conservation for their continued support, contribution and inputs. AM proposed a WhatsApp group for FMK 	AM
